Building off the theme of "The Magic of Teamwork," the 2026 Lutheran Hour Ministries float entry is titled "Bringing Christ to the Nations" and marks the 75th time the ministry has been part of the parade. The float will feature a "team Jesus" blimp flying over the world. Coming forth from the church, Jesus celebrates with 12 modern-day disciples, as it features the message ALL WELCOME. "Team Jesus" serves as a reminder that it takes everyone to fulfill the callings Christ has placed upon us to do the work of bringing Christ and His redeeming love to the world. Riders on the 2026 float will represent some of the vocations Christ has called us for the building of His church and furtherance of the Gospel message: a teacher, a missionary, a pastor, and others. Additional symbolism will include the Luther Seal on the nose of the blimp, crosses on the side, "75" on the tail in honor of the 75th year having a Christian float in the parade and a Petal Pushers banner to highlight the annual volunteer efforts of around 4,000 individuals. The float will be positioned as the 33rd entry and pass the grandstand about 40 to 50 minutes after the start of the parade.
